Quietways Drop-in Meeting for Gipsy Hill Ward

As your local councillors we want to ensure that the TfL Quietways route through the ward is designed with local residents, businesses and road users, to ensure the best possible design that works for everybody.

In recent weeks, a number of residents have contacted us with questions on the scheme including specific elements about safety, the location of crossings and changes to junctions in Gipsy Hill Ward.

We have therefore organised a surgery with the designers, so that residents have the chance to raise these issues directly with the officers who are redrafting the plans.
